Bankapura is about 50 km from Hubli in the Bangalore-Hubli Main Road, and 10 KM from Haveri. The Keshava Temple is in a very small temple. Sri Kanakadasaru has praised this temple in some of his krutees. This Keshava idol is said to have the prastiste by Sri Vyasarajaru. This Keshava idol has Tantrasarokta lakshana and has special sannidhana.

The Keshava idol has Shanka, Padma, Gadha and Sudarshana, and he is served by Brahma Rudradi gods, its eyes resembles lotus, Keshava with his "humkara" dhwani removes all fear.

Pandarapura is a Vaishnava kshetra.

Panduranga Vittala stays on the banks of the river Bheemarathi. It is in Maharashtra. It is about 60 KM from Sollapura. There is a pouranika story which says that Panduranga Vittala stood there to please one of his devotee named Pundarikamuni, who continued serving his aged parents even after Vittala came and stood before him. As Vittala was pleased with his devotee, he stood there itself as Panduranga Vittala. Here Bheemarathi (Bheema) river surrounds the city in half Chandrakruti and it is also called as Chandrabhaga. The river joins Krishna River.

By staying near Bheemarathi River, Panduranga Vittala says that his devotees must stay near sacred rivers, we should have virakthi, and also says through holding Shanka Chakra symbols that Urdwapundradharana, Taptamudradharana, etc Vaishnava symbols are a must for every one. He also points one of his finger to his feet which says that everyone must serve Srihari's lotus feet. By holding one of his hands on his waist, he says that if one follows Vaishnava route, by applying Mudradharana, do the seva of Srihari, our samsara samudra will be shortened upto waist only. By holding "danda" between his thigh, he says that if we are not following the above method, then he will punish.





In Pandarapura, there is a pillar in Pandurangavittala temple, as a token of special anugraha to Purandaradasaru. Sri Jagannatha Dasaru got his ankita Jagannatha Vittala in this place only. There is vrundavana sannidhana of Sri Vedanidhi Tirtharu, and Sri Satyadhyana Tirtharu in Uttaradimutt at Pandarapura. It is said that Sri Raghavendra Tirtharu had done one Chaturmasya in this kshetra.
