

Sri Vadiraja Tirtha's Thirtha Prabandha on Kanchi Varadaraja

चि वरदराज — कंचि वरदराज — चिंकुः वर्वविक्षः चिंकुः चिंकुः

चेतनाचेतनजगद्वरं त्वामेव देहि मे ॥ ३२ ॥ द्विजेष्टदातृत्वमजार्चितत्त्वमजन्मतां स्वां मखभोकृतां च । व्यनक्त्ययं श्रीपतिरग्रहारपरीतधातृक्रतुवेदिजातः ॥ ३३ ॥

There are two kanchis. One is Vishnukanchi and the other one Shivakanchi. Srihari in his roopa of Varadaraja is staying in Vishnukanchi. The idol had come out of the yajna which was performed by Brahmadeva, as per the sthala purana. As he came out of the Yajnabhoomi it indicates his Brahmavandyatva, Yajnabhoktrutva, vedijaatattva, and janmaraahithya.

Srihari is the shresta among those who give boon, that is why he is called as "varadaraja". Vadirajaru here says in utprekshalankara that Varadaraja is a "rasika" that is why he is staying in bhoodevi's Kaanchi.

The idol is very beautiful. Sri Vyasarajaru stayed here for many years and it is here that Sri Vyasarajaru wrote:

श्रीमन्मध्वमते हिरः परतरः सत्यं जगत्तत्वतो । भेदो जीवगणाः हरेरनुचराः नीचोच्च भावंगताः । मुक्तिर्नेज सुखानुभूतिरमला भिक्तश्च तत्साधनं । ह्यक्ष्यादित्रितयं प्रमाणमिखलाम्नायैक वेद्योहिरः ॥

He explained the entire contents of Madhwa Philosophy in a single prose, after defeating so many stalwarts of Advaita philosophy at a very young age.
